## Up to 3 semester scholarships as recognition for commitment

The semester scholarships are provided proportionally by DAAD's STIBET I project, using funding from the Federal Foreign Office, and from HSBI's internal quality improvement funds. In principle, all international HSBI students enrolled in Bachelor's or Master's degree programmes are eligible for the scholarships. The prerequisite for funding is that the students have shown good academic performance and outstanding commitment in their university's international context.

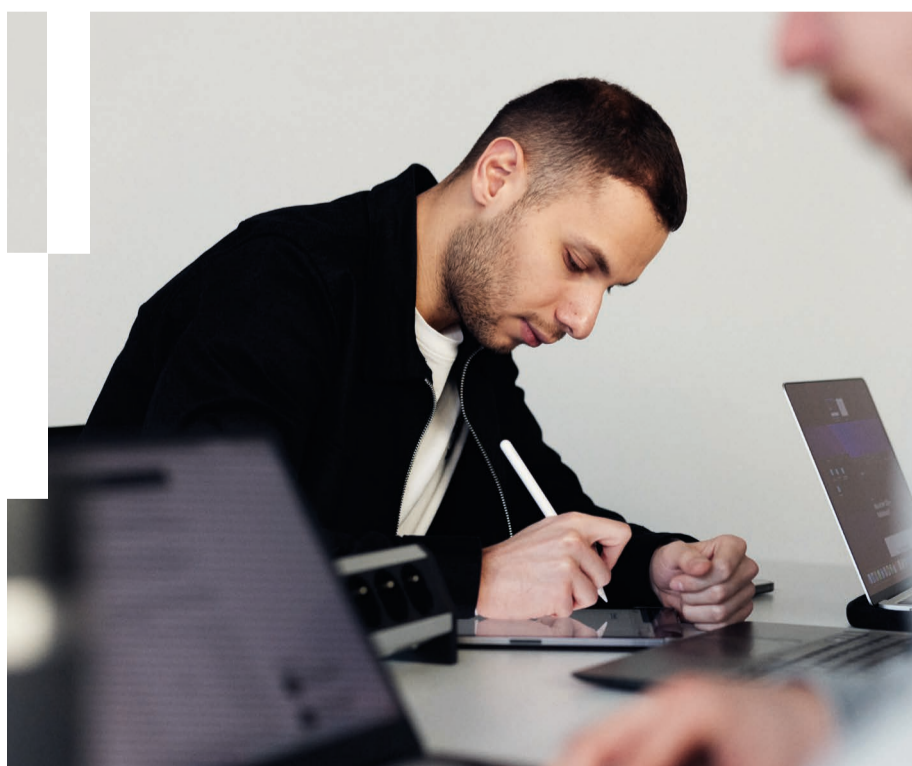
### Pre-Selection Process:

According to a points system of up to **100 points**, they can achieve up to **70 points** for good academic performance (that is their own grade compared to the average grade of their own study programme). For this purpose, we calculate a relative grade, which we compare to the grade of other applicants.

Your intercultural commitment can earn yourself up to **30 additional points**.

- At least one year of proven international commitment: **10 points**
- Several years or multiple forms of commitment over 2 years: **20 points**
- Several years and multiple forms of commitment over 2 years: **30 points**

The commitment must not date back more than 3 years (that is before June 2023).

## Application criteria

Students who fulfil the following requirements may apply for a scholarship:

### General prerequisites:

1. Non-German nationality (**no** dual citizenship)
2. Acquisition of the university entrance qualification/eligibility for your **current studies** abroad
3. Regular matriculation as a student at HSBI in the winter semester 2026/2027
4. Good academic performance in comparison to your fellow students
5. Proof of intercultural commitment at the university

### Necessary documents:

- A motivational letter
- CV
- Current transcript including your average grade
- Proof of intercultural commitment

- Once you have sent the application form successfully, you will definitely receive an e-mail. Please **fill in the form again** should you not receive an automated acknowledgement of receipt.
- Only when you receive a confirmation via e-mail can you be sure that we have received your application.

### Selection procedure

The students who will receive a scholarship will be selected by a committee with representatives from the International Office, the student union and the Equal Opportunity Office. If you are eligible for the scholarship, you will be invited to an individual 15-minute interview. Please keep the morning of 19 August 2026 free for this.
