1.2 Course Restrictions

Unless the student exchange agreement with your home institution specifies otherwise, you can take any courses you wish with the following exceptions:

1. Any courses described in [Bear Tracks](#) as being closed to exchange students (see below for more information about Bear Tracks).
2. [Courses with non-standard fees](#)
3. [Alternate delivery sections of any UAlberta courses](#)
4. Courses from the Faculties of Medicine & Dentistry (with the exception of courses in the Departments of Biochemistry, Cell Biology, and Physiology), Nursing, Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences, and Rehabilitation Medicine
5. Courses at the School of Library and Information Studies, Yukon University, Bamfield Marine Sciences Centre, and in the Faculty of Education's English Language School
6. Courses for field schools, work placements, or practice
7. SOC 399 (Field Placement in Criminology) and SOC 499 (Advanced Field Placement in Criminology).
8. Various courses in the Alberta School of Business, including BTM 441, BUS 101, BUS 201, BUS 301, FIN 430, FIN 436, FIN 440, MGTSC 312, SEM 310, SEM 441, SEM 470, and SEM 471, independent research, internship, study tour, competition, work experience, Honours (numbered 480) and Special Topic (numbered 488) courses
9. Various courses in the Department of Renewable Resources, including REN R 301, 401-405, 501, 603-605, and 900+ courses
10. The School of Public Health's SPH 603 course

Please note these other restrictions:

1. **There is no guarantee of registration in the courses you may want or need.** Some courses might not be offered even though they have been in the past, some courses may fill up even before you have a chance to register in them, and/or UAlberta officials may determine that you don't have the necessary prerequisites for some courses. It's best to prepare a list of alternative courses in the event that some of your initial selections are unavailable.
2. Unless your exchange is taking place at the Augustana Campus you must not plan to take courses there (i.e., avoid courses having course codes starting with "AU"). Augustana Campus is located in the town of Camrose which is about 100 km south of Edmonton.
3. It is highly unlikely that you'll be able to take many (if any) courses in the Departments of Art & Design (with the exception of HADVC courses, ART 134, and DEC 135), Computing Science, Drama (with the exception of DRAMA 101, 102, and 149), and Economics. Courses in these departments are in extremely high demand and often fill up quickly.
4. You can only take courses in the Alberta School of Business or in the

Faculties of Engineering; Law; or Kinesiology, Sport, and Recreation if you are admitted to one of those faculties for your exchange.

5. Students interested in an undergraduate-level exchange to UAlberta's Faculty of Law Juris Doctor program should know that it is an after-degree, professional program. The other students in the program will each have at least a 3-year bachelor's degree. Students without similar academic backgrounds are strongly encouraged to discuss their plans with academic advisors at their home institutions before applying for the exchange and seek permission to, if need be, take fewer than the maximum number of courses allowable per term while on exchange.
6. Undergraduate students must take all or a majority of their courses in the same faculty.
7. Please be realistic about your course selections. For example, if you've only ever studied chemistry at your home institution, please don't think you'll be permitted to register in upper-year philosophy courses during your exchange at UAlberta.
8. Undergraduate students can't take more than 15 credits worth of courses (typically 5 courses) per term while for graduate / postgraduate students the maximum is 9 credits worth of courses (typically 3 courses) per term.
9. The majority of courses you take should be in the same faculty (for undergraduate students) or department (for graduate / postgraduate students).
10. Exchange students cannot audit courses.
11. Undergraduate students cannot conduct research.
12. Graduate students can take courses or conduct research, but not both.
13. Graduate students wanting to conduct research will need to find a host supervisor at UAlberta **before** they submit their exchange applications.
